Board Meeting Minutes - March 16, 2026

1. **Call to Order** - Meeting was called to order by Robert at 7:05pm. In attendance were Robert, Doug, Janice, Leti, Lisa and April. We also welcomed guest Mike Vansteel. Janice moved and was seconded by April to approve Phyllis as the new treasurer and Lisa as the new secretary.

8. **The Porch Crawl** - April shared that we have some new committee members, including Mike Vansteel! It was determined that we will move the event to November 7th with a Chili Cook Off theme. To fill

the void in May/June for an event, we hope to reserve the Glenville Pool for a Summer Kick-Off on June 6th . We approved the cost of

\$150-\$200 for the rental of the pool. Robert made the motion and it was seconded by Leti.
